SPOND is not only a more robust and user-friendly platform, but it's also significantly more cost-effective, helping us save valuable resources to invest back into the club.

You may have already received some notification emails from SPOND - if so, don't worry! Below, you'll find clear instructions to help you get set up and make the transition smooth. In the next few weeks, you will start to receive membership fee notifications from the app:

- **SPOND users**: Notifications will appear in the app's payments section. Follow the onscreen instructions to pay.
- Non-SPOND Users: Look out for an automated email from SPOND with payment instructions.

If you have any questions or need assistance, please reach out to Inge Bevers or Simon Hunter. Simon will also be available at the Men's Winter Nets with the U15s for any help you might need.

Accessing SPOND

All members (both playing and social) who are new to SPOND:

- Download the SPOND app from your app store.
- Create an account, and follow the instructions to join using the appropriate group code on the right.

Senior Men's kit:


